- Unofficial school transcripts
- One (1) letter of recommendation from a faculty member of the school you are currently attending or from a registered Professional Engineer at a company or government agency you worked for within the past year (e.g., internship).
- Full Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- List significant involvement and leadership roles with ASCE Student Chapter, other engineering student groups, and other community involvement/service activities on separate page(s)
